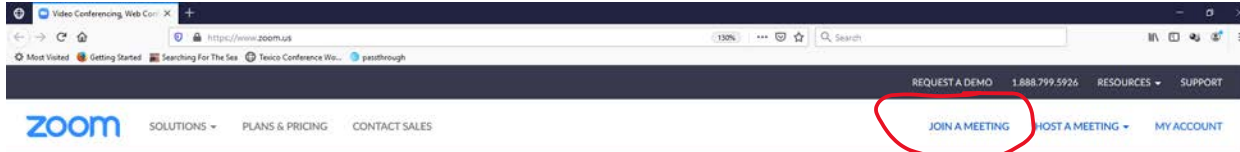
Dear Pathfinders and Parents:

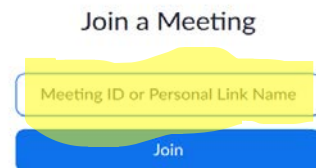
We still plan to have activities and a patch for each Pathfinder who participates in the fair activities. There will not be any charge for the patch this year. The activities will be Zoom led with times to be online and times to be offline. We are including a schedule to show you when you will need to be on the Zoom program. During the activities on Sunday morning, you will need to have some supplies to use to accomplish the activity. We will e-mail you a list of what you will need for this. If you do not have all the supplies or cannot get them, please plan to participate in a different activity.

We will have a devotional time along with the opening exercises and uniform inspection first. If a Pathfinder in your household would like to lead out in one of the opening activities, please indicate on your registration form. We want to have this as interactive as possible.

Since a lot of this will be online, you will have to have access to the internet on a phone, iPad (or other tablet) or a computer. The program we will use is Zoom. You need to go to [Zoom.us](https://zoom.us) and download it as an app on the phone or iPad or as a program on your computer. Each time you log in you will go to Zoom.us and click the "join a meeting" button.



After that you need to enter the meeting ID code that we will email you once we receive your registration form. Once you do that, make sure that you mute your mic and turn on your video. We want all video's on so the participants can be seen. We have had a problem with some outside people "bombing" Zoom meetings with inappropriate chats and pictures.
